How to Apply

Complete and return the enclosed application with four (4) professional quality images of current work (less than two years old) for publicity purposes. Formats accepted include photographic prints or high-resolution (300 dpi) jpeg, tiff or pdf digital images on CD. Clearly label each image with your name. (Without your images, there's no poster or postcard.)

Artists who have been juried in previously in more than one medium for any one year may exhibit in those media; however, *all submissions in a medium other than previously accepted must be juried and accompanied by images and jury fee.* Artists may submit multiple applications; however, all submissions in a single entry must be in one category only. Images will be returned **only** if an appropriately sized S.A.S.E. envelope with proper postage is included with entry.

Entry Deadline

Entries must be postmarked by March 12, 2010. Notification of acceptance will be mailed by April 2, 2010.

Booth Information

Standard booth space is 10' wide x 12' deep with 2' walk-around area. Booths are assigned based on date of application and location needed for a given medium. Art on the Lawn is limited to 75 booths.

Artists provide their own complete displays, including any tables or chairs. A canopy is recommended.

Two artists may share a booth, providing they have made arrangements in advance and each is juried into the show. *****Each artist is responsible for his or her own \$60 booth fee.*****

Fees

The booth fee is \$60. **Artists sharing a booth are each responsible for their own \$60 fee.** All fees must be received by May 3, 2010. For artists without canopies, a limited number of 10' x 10' booth spaces under our tent are available on a first-come, first-served basis for an additional \$50 each. **DO NOT send booth fees with application.**

Awards

Art on the Lawn is judged by a professional judge. A total of four cash prizes will be awarded for best of show and runner-up for both 2D and 3D. Amounts TBA.

Program/Postcards

A program listing artists, media and booth numbers is distributed free of charge to attendees.

Artists receive 25 full-color postcard invitations for their own mailings. Additional postcards are available for a nominal fee.

Set-up

Check-in/setup begins at 6:00AM on the day of the show. Artists must be checked in by 8:30AM.

Artists may begin setting up on Saturday, June 12, from noon to 5:00PM. Overnight security is provided, however, Rockford College is not responsible for loss or damage to any property left unattended.

Show Rules

- 1) All work must be the artist's own original, creative work and must be presented in a finished manner. Work that is mass produced or purchased from other artists may not be sold.
- 2) The show committee reserves the right to refuse exhibition of work not consistent with submitted materials.
- 3) Artists must be present for the entire show and must remain set up until the close of the show.
- 4) Artists are not permitted to change space assignments. See the show director if there is a problem.
- 5) No vehicles are allowed in the loading/unloading area until after the show closes at 5:00PM.

Returning Artist Application and Rules

Applicants

- 1. Complete and return the enclosed application with four (4) professional quality images of current work (less than two years old) for publicity purposes. Formats accepted include photographic prints or high-resolution (300 dpi) jpeg, tiff or pdf digital images on CD. Clearly label each image with your name. (Without your images, there's no poster or postcard.) Artists who have been juried in previously in more than one medium for any one year may exhibit in those media; however, all submissions in a medium other than previously accepted must be juried and accompanied by images and \$10 jury fee. ***Do NOT include booth fee with application.***
- 2. Please include a self-addressed, stamped envelope sized appropriately for the return of your entries. Entries without proper envelope or sufficient postage will not be returned.
- 3. Notification of acceptance will be mailed by April 2, 2010. Booths are 10' w x 12' d. A booth fee of \$60 is due by May 3.
